Call Index

- 0 - None - No calls
- 1 - Individuals - Individuals can be counted; there is space between calls
- 2 - Overlapping - Calls of individuals can be distinguished but there is some overlapping
- 3 - Continuous Chorus - Full chorus, calls are constant, continuous and overlapping

Sky Code

- 0 - Few clouds - Few clouds
- 1 - Partly cloudy - Partly cloudy (scattered) or variable sky
- 2 - Cloudy - Cloudy or overcast
- 4 - Fog or Smoke - Fog or Smoke
- 5 - Drizzle or light rain - Drizzle or light rain (not affecting hearing ability)
- 7 - Snow - Snow
- 8 - Showers - Showers (is affecting hearing ability) - do not conduct survey

Wind Speed: Beaufot Scale

- 0 - Calm - (<1 mph) smoke rises vertically
- 1 - Light Air - (1-3 mph) smoke drifts, weather vane inactive
- 2 - Light Breeze - (4-7 mph) leaves rustle, can feel wind on face
- 3 - Gentle Breeze - (8-12 mph) leaves and twigs move around, small flag extends
- 4 - Moderate Breeze - (13-18 mph) moves thin branches, raises loose papers
- 5 - Fresh Breeze - (> 19 mph) small trees begin to sway
